Participation	All	<p>All participants to be briefed on the operating procedures for cricket at Tilford via information on the Tilford Cricket Club website and clear display of the ECB infograms at points around the ground.</p> <p>All participants should check for Covid19 symptoms prior to leaving home and must NOT attend if they exhibit any signs of the illness.</p> <p>Any prospective participants who have been asked to isolate must NOT attend.</p> <p>Any participant developing Covid19 symptoms up to 7 days after a match should notify the club so that NHS Track & Trace can be notified.</p>	
Registration	All	<p>The club shall record the names and contact details of all participants:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • TCC Members & Guests • Opposition Members & Guests

Playing Area	Players & Umpires	<p>Play shall be conducted in line with latest ECB guidance:</p> <p>Socially Distanced Matches</p> <p>Highlights are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Players to remain socially distanced at all times. • Non-striker to run down marked line to avoid bowler. • Hands and balls to be sanitised every 20 minutes or 6 overs. • No sweat or saliva to be applied to the ball. • Ball top be returned directly to the bowler. • Umpire not to handle the ball or any players' clothing or equipment. • Batsmen to clean their bat on leaving the field of play. • No food to be prepared for players or officials 	
Scorer's Table	Scorers	<p>Area to be clearly identified and signed.</p> <p>Only scorers to be allowed within area.</p> <p>If more than one scorer, social distancing to be maintained in line with latest UK Government guidelines.</p>	
Pitch Surrounds	All	<p>Social distancing to be maintained in line with latest UK Government guidelines.</p> <p>Area next to Tilford Institute has been cleared to provide a larger area for members of the batting side and other club members and officials.</p>	
Equipment Store	All	<p>Only one person at a time to be permitted in the equipment store.</p> <p>Store to be kept locked whenever possible.</p>	

Scorebox	All	Only one person at a time to be permitted in the scorebox. Scorebox to be kept locked whenever possible.	
Scoreboard	All	Only one person shall use the scoreboard and/or remote control. If the responsible person needs to change then the equipment shall be thoroughly sanitised before handover.	
Changing Rooms	All	Changing rooms will NOT be used for player's changing. All players are required to arrive changed.	
Toilets	All	Social distancing to be maintained within toilets with only one person in each facility at any time.	
Tea Room	All	The tea room will NOT be used. Players are required to provide their own food and drink.	
Club Equipment	All	All club equipment used during the game, including but not limited to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stumps • Bails • Scoreboard • Scorer's Table shall be cleaned on completion of the game before being packed away.	
Personal Equipment	All	Personal equipment shall NOT be shared between players.	
Hygiene & Cleaning	All	The club shall provide sanitisation facilities in the form of: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hand washing with soap and water in the toilets • Alcohol-based sanitation stations around the Tilford Institute and playing area. • Suitable hand wipes and hand sanitiser on the field of play for hygiene breaks All participants are encouraged to bring their own hand sanitisation products for use during play.
